Based on the results and issues in the previous Three-year Business Plan, BEACON 2030 Phase I, Nihon Kohden has partially reviewed its material issues and KPIs for sustainability, and created the SDGs Matrix. The SDGs Matrix identifies the main goals and targets to which our material issues and KPIs can contribute, in relation to the 17 goals and 169 targets indicated by the SDGs. By identifying materialities using the SDGs as a compass, we can take a strategic approach by incorporating a sustainability perspective into our management.
